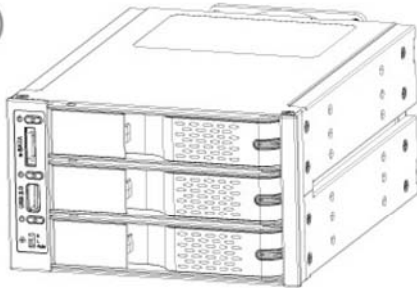

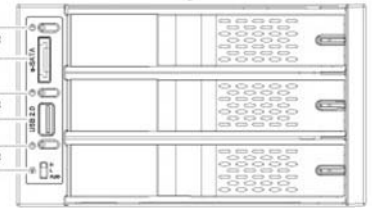

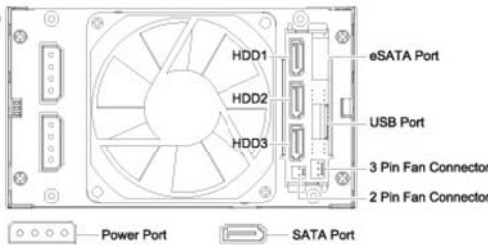

Fan Speed Control



- The LED indicator illuminates in blue after the hard drive is inserted into the drive bay, it will remain off if the drive bay is empty.
- The LED indicator will flash blue during drive access.
- Fan speed can be set to High, Low, and Auto. In Auto mode, fan RPM automatically adjusts according to the temperature of the drives, creating more or less airflow to meet the demands of the system.
- The USB 2.0 and eSATA port on the front of the panel is made for external device usage. In order to make them function, please make sure to connect the USB 2.0 and the SATA connector (for front eSATA port) on the rear to the motherboard.
- The fan will be activated after the hard drive is inserted.

3 Rear Panel Information

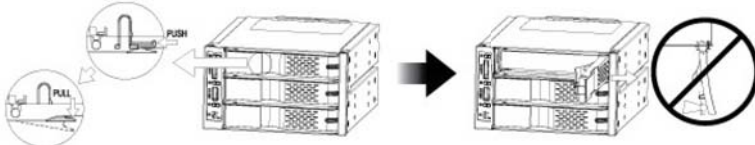
- The device is equipped with a 2Pin and a 3Pin connector for the fan power. Please select the compatible one for the fan replacement.
- Both 4-PIN power connections must be used for proper operation of the enclosure.

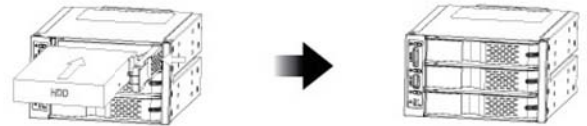


Power Port SATA Port

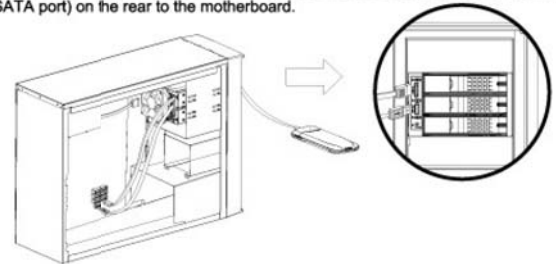
4 Instructions

<A> Push the release button and pull the handle to open the front panel.



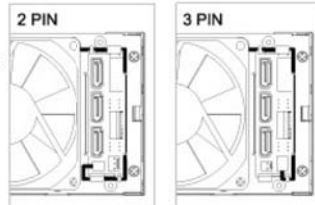
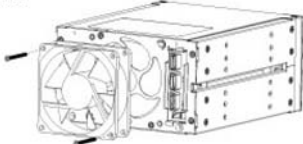


<C>The USB 2.0 and eSATA port on the front of the panel is made for external device usage. In order to make them function, please make sure to connect the USB 2.0 and the SATA connector (for front eSATA port) on the rear to the motherboard.



<D> Fan Replacement Information

- To purchase a replacement fan, please make sure the fan connector is compatible to the 2PIN or 3PIN connections of the device.
